Practicals: Simple and complex elements of social dance technique (steps, leaps, jumps, rolls). Methodology, techniques and rhythm of the basic steps of social dances: English Waltz, Foxtrot, Tango, Cha-cha-cha, salsa, rock and roll. Dance and music game (by applying the basic steps of social dances performed various dance competition game applicable in physical education, sport and recreation).
